

## HOW DO YOU GET THERE?...

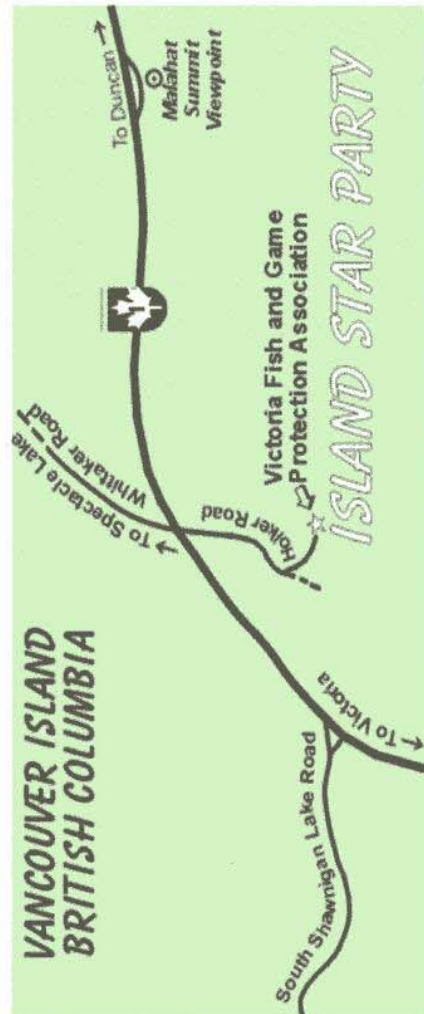
From Victoria, follow Highway #1 north to the Spectacle Lake turnoff. Turn right on Holker Road.

From the north, follow Highway #1 south from Duncan, past the Malahat Summit Viewpoint to the Spectacle Lake turnoff. Turn left on Holker Road.
